4 Tips Employers Encourage All Attendees to do Before Talking with a Representative

1) Do your research and get to know the companies you want to talk with. Go to the employer's website and social media pages. Read up on their organization.

2) Find potential job opportunities. Search the company's career pages on their websites. You may be able to search open positions you could be qualified for. In addition, visit jobs boards and LinkedIn. Bring these positions (and the links to those jobs) with you during your conversations at the Expo.

3) Develop talking points. Make your conversations meaningful. Employers want to know where you'll bring value to their organization. Bring a list of prepared questions with you.

4) Submit Your resume during registration. Try to keep your resume no more than two pages. Keep it bullet pointed and no long paragraphs. They scan for what they're looking for. Pull keywords from the positions description and tailor you resume to the job you are applying for.
